

Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club Bylaws

Preamble

Recognizing the value of a strong well-supported golf program to Chaparral High School's mission of developing whole persons; and knowing the importance athletics plays in the lives of students and parents of the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club.

Purpose

The sole purpose of the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club is to generate fan support and financial backing for the Chaparral High School Golf Program.

1. To encourage parent support and to develop an appreciation for the role of the sport of golf at Chaparral High School.
2. To provide financial opportunities for individuals and corporations to show their interest in the golf program at Chaparral High School, hopefully, beyond their usual level of support.
3. To appropriately assist in making all of the golf programs and opportunities known to potential student-athletes.

Specific Guidelines

1. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club is a voluntary group of interested persons, open to all, who specifically want to support the Chaparral High School Golf Program.
2. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club is an officially recognized and appreciated organization by the Chaparral High School Administration; and when operating properly, serves Chaparral High School as an important auxiliary program
3. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club will use the services of the booster clubs elected treasurer in administering and accounting of all its funds. A detailed treasurer's report will be furnished at each meeting and will be available upon request.
4. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club affirms the validity of the Arizona Interscholastic Athletics in setting rules and awarding accreditation of Chaparral High Schools athletic programs. As such, the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club will do nothing to jeopardize Chaparral High School or its athletes with the AIA, or any other regulatory body.
5. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club will work closely with the Chaparral High School Head Golf Coach and any designated golf coaches in determining programs and opportunities for appropriate involvement.
6. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club does not have authority to set policy for the golf program, but is encouraged to make suggestions for the good of the entire golf program.
7. All final decisions regarding the allocation of funds will be solely decided by the Head Golf Coach.
8. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club, or individual members of the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club do not have authority in act in, or use the name of Chaparral High School without the expressed written consent of the Chaparral High School Administration.
9. Whenever it appears that the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club is no longer serving its purpose, or in the best interest of Chaparral High School and/or the Chaparral High School Golf Program; or if the Chaparral High School Head Golf Coach deems that the booster club is no longer serving a purpose in the best interests of Chaparral High School and/or the Chaparral High School Golf Program, the recognition and relationship of the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club will be dissolved.
10. Should the Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club be dissolved, all monies will be deposited into the appropriate school account, i.e. the General Golf Account run through the Chaparral High School Bookstore.

Organization

1. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club shall be guided by an Executive Board composed of an elected President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
2. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Executive Officers shall initially be elected by the parents of the Chaparral High School Golf Team Members. The committee will be self-perpetuating.
3. Nominees and Elected officers must be in good standing with the Chaparral High School Head Golf Coach, and be willing to positively support the Chaparral High School Head Golf Coach and the Chaparral High School Golf Program.
4. The Chaparral High School Men's Golf Booster Club will elect an Executive Board and the officers of the board must be approved by the Chaparral High School Head Golf Coach.
